

## Commissioned Artwork:

First, thank you so much for supporting my creative journey and thinking of me for this project. Let me share with you a little bit about the process.

My mosaic pieces can be complex and take some time to create, which is one reason I love making them. Each one is a unique, handmade piece that can't be easily duplicated. I like to use the picassiette style (broken dishes), but I also enjoy using beautiful stained-glass. Glass mosaics can be opaque or translucent depending on what you like.

Each piece can take from 10 - 80+ hours to make depending on the design and size. Prices range from \$300 - \$2,500 for a completed, ready to hang piece. Price is determined by the size, materials, and complexity of design. For a custom piece, it may take from 30-90 days to complete.

The first step is to decide on the subject. I can work from a photo or do a sketch. As the piece progresses, I will send progress shots to make sure we stay on track. Finally, I don't ask for a deposit, and if you are not happy with the final product, you are not required to purchase the piece.

A few things to consider before we start: design, approximate size; opaque or translucent; specific materials you'd like to incorporate (mementos?); and of course, your budget.
